



**RULES FOR ASSESSMENT THROUGH COMPENSATION FOR A
COMPLETION OF STUDIES FROM THE FACULTY OF MEDICINE
FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF LEIDA**

(approved by the Study Committee on June 28, 2021 and by the Governing Council on July 22, 2021)

PREAMBLE

The compensation assessment is a possibility that allows students to overcome a limited number of compulsory credits in their ordinary calls and which are significant in the overall educational development of the career.

Compensation assessment aims to add, to the traditional system, an alternative form of assessment that takes into account the student's overall trajectory. So, in addition to the requirement of certain levels of knowledge in each subject, it assesses the set of results of the student and their skills in order to integrate into the professional world.

There are two types of compensation assessment (curricular and non-curricular) and two modalities of implementation (in the first year of Bachelor's studies and upon completion of Bachelor's studies). The University of Lleida, in its "Regulations on the evaluation and qualification of teaching in the UdL's degrees and master's", provides for the system of evaluation by compensation in articles 3.3 and 3.4.

Given that these regulations may be subject to development by teaching centers in those aspects expressly provided for, the Faculty of Medicine (FM) formulates the following particular regulations for evaluation by compensation applicable to their Degree studies.

ARTICLE 1. EVALUATION METHODS FOR COMPENSATION

1. The FM chooses to host and develop the evaluation for non-curricular compensation, i only for completion of studies.
2. Given that the "Regulations on the evaluation and qualification of teaching in grades i masters of the UdL", in its article 3.3 establishes that the evaluation method for non-curricular compensation in the first year of a degree is optional, the FM chooses not to apply this mode of evaluation and host and develop the mode of evaluation no curriculum for compensation only for completion of studies.
3. The evaluation for compensation for completion of Degree studies of the FM, in its modality of non-curricular evaluation, consists of an evaluation mechanism through the which a global assessment of the student's file is carried out with the aim of determine his general aptitude for obtaining the corresponding degree when he lacks for pass a certain number of credits and have not been able to do so through the evaluation channels ordinary

ARTICLE 2. SCOPE OF APPLICATION

These regulations apply to Bachelor's degree programs taught at the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Lleida.



ARTICLE 3. NON-CURRICULAR EVALUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR COMPENSATION FOR COMPLETION OF DEGREE STUDIES OF THE FM

To be able to opt for the evaluation for non-curricular compensation for completion of studies, all the following requirements must be met:

- Only a maximum of one subject can be compensated and this must be the maximum 6 ECTS. Requests for compensation for more than one subject or that subject exceeding 6 ECTS will be rejected.
- The student who requests the evaluation of a subject for compensation for completion of studies must have exhausted the number of ordinary calls for the subject, that is that is, to have taken it during three academic years and to have obtained one in all of them suspended rating.
- It will not be possible to ask for the compensation of credits corresponding to the subjects electives, the End of Degree Project (TFG) or clinical practices or practices extracurricular academics.
- To be able to be evaluated for the subject for non-curricular compensation, you must have obtained in one of the exhausted calls for this subject a minimum qualification of 4 out of 10.
- The student must be enrolled and assessed for the subject for which he/she is applying compensation during the same academic year in which the application is submitted.
- The rest of the subjects that make up the study plan of the degree or double degree they must be approved, with the exception of the TFG; being an indispensable condition that the student/a is enrolled in the TFG of the Degree during the academic year for which the request is made compensation.

ARTICLE 4. AUTHORITY COMPETENT TO RESOLVE NON-CURRICULAR ASSESSMENT REQUESTS FOR COMPLETION OF DEGREE AND DOUBLE DEGREE STUDIES OF THE FM

Requests for compensation will be resolved by the dean of the FM, prior to the report of the Study Committee. The Faculty Board, if it deems it necessary, may create a specific committee; if this happens, it will replace the Studies Committee in the preparation of the report.

ARTICLE 5. GENERAL ACTION CRITERIA OF THE STUDIES COMMITTEE OF THE FM FOR THE DRAWING OF THE REPORT

1. The competent body to resolve the requests will assess, in a global way, the trajectory academic of the student throughout his university studies, will analyze them qualifications that appear in your academic record and all the information complementary that it considers appropriate to justify its decisions. Likewise,



will ensure compliance with the criteria of transparency and fairness, and will avoid discriminatory actions.

2. He/she will not be able to perform exam tests on the student involved.
3. Prepare a report with the results of the evaluation for non-curricular compensation of the subject that will be delivered to the Dean of the FM.

ARTICLE 6. PROCEDURE AND REGIME OF RESOURCES

1. The student who meets ALL the requirements described in article 3 of these regulations, may submit the request for compensation of qualifications within five working days from the day after the closing day of acts corresponding to any of the official calls for the academic year for final year students.
2. The request must be submitted to the electronic register of the University of Lleida addressed to the dean of the FM. The reasons for not passing the subject for which compensation is requested must be stated.
3. The decision of the competent body will be notified to the student requesting the assessment for compensation within thirty working days from the day after the end of the period to request the assessment for compensation
4. In the event that the resolution is not favorable, an appeal may be filed before the rector, within one month from the day after notification of the resolution. Against this resolution, which exhausts the administrative avenue, an administrative appeal can be filed within two months from the date on which the resolution is notified.
5. In the event that the decision of the competent body is favorable, the secretary of this body will transfer it to the academic secretary of the FM so that he incorporates the qualification of passed in the record of the subject. This subject, with the sole purpose of grading the student's academic record, can only be counted with a grade of 5.
6. The qualification will be recorded in the evaluation call corresponding to the academic year in which the application has been approved.

TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS

The assessment regulations for non-curricular compensation for completion of FM studies will enter into force in the 2021-2022 academic year.
